Choirs Adjudicator Dallas Bergen

Dallas Bergen is an active singer, choral conductor and clinician from Toronto. Hailing from Regina, SK, Dallas found his passion for choral singing during his high school years which included singing with the Saskatchewan Honour Choir where he sang under the direction of esteemed Ontario conductors, Doreen Rao and Gerald Fagan. Prior to settling in Toronto, Dallas received his Bachelor of Music in Secondary Education from the University of Victoria. He is a past member of The Canadian Chamber Choir and The Nathaniel Dett Chorale and appeared with the Elora Festival Singers for the 2008 festival choir. He is the founding member of Univox Choirs Toronto, a community choirs organization for young adults founded on the principles of relationship



building, social responsibility and musical excellence. He is music director at First Unitarian Congregation. Dallas appeared in the 2015 Luminato production of R. Murray Schafer's Apocalypsis, leading the 120-voice SATB choir working under Music Director, David Fallis. Dallas' service to the choral world extends to his work with Regent Park School of Music where he is the founding director of the Parkdale satellite choir, and co-director of Nai Syrian Children's Choir. He recently completed nine years of service on the music committee of the Toronto Arts Council as juror and co-chair. Recent workshops have included the Unitarian Universalist Association, New Choir Toronto, Toronto Youth Wind Orchestra and CAMMAC (Canadian Amateur Musicians/Musiciens amateurs du Canada). Dallas strives to use his passion for choral music to foster empathy and human connection through the vulnerability of shared artistic expression. When Dallas isn't leading choirs he enjoys spending time with his family outdoors--hiking, fishing, camping--and travelling to the far regions of the earth.
